



# Senior Home Heating Subsidy

## What is Senior Home Heating Subsidy?

The Senior Home Heating Subsidy (SHHS) provides financial assistance to low income seniors to offset the high costs of heating their homes.

Senior homeowners may be eligible to receive a set amount of either wood, wood pellets, fuel oil, propane, natural gas and/or electricity for heating, depending on household income and the community they live in.

The SHHS is for seniors who:

- ◆ Are residents of the Northwest Territories;
- ◆ Are 60 years of age or older;
- ◆ Own and live in their own home;
- ◆ Meet a household income test (applicant and spouse only);
- ◆ Are not receiving Income Assistance; and
- ◆ Apply each year
